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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ENROLMENT

Enrolment for classes at Aelita Rhythmic Gymnastics Club Inc (hereby known as 'Aelita') is confirmed by completing all sections of the enrolment form, agreeing to the Terms and Conditions here, and forwarding to the above address.

PAYMENT

Tax invoices will be provided once enrolment forms have been processed and accounts must be paid in full within 14 days. Payments can be made via cash or direct debit. In the event that payment is not made by the required date, the gymnast concerned may be stopped from participating further in classes. Payments are non-refundable.

CANCELLATION

All enrolments will be secured from the start of Term 1 to end of Term 4 each year and will carry over into each new term unless notified. If a gymnast is enrolled after the commencement of a term, she will only be liable for the tuition fees from that time. In the event that a gymnast decides not to continue with classes, written confirmation must be sent to Aelita. All fees are non-refundable although the gymnast may apply to have fees credited towards future classes, provided they obtain management approval.

UNIFORM

Gymnasts are to wear closely fitted clothing (club top & bike shorts / leggings / leotard / socks), single colour preferred, to ensure coaches can see correct body alignment to prevent injuries. Hair must be in a neat bun or if short hair, pinned neatly away from the face. Remember to bring a bottle of water to keep hydrated. No other food or beverage is allowed into the gym. For upgrades and competitions, gymnasts **MUST** wear only club approved leotards.

ATTENDANCE & LATENESS

Parents are to notify the coach if a gymnast is to be absent. If there is another similar class option available, missed classes can be made up only within the term that it was missed, else absence at a class will result in the gymnast forfeiting the class fee. During display preparations in June / July and November / December, make up classes will not be an option. In the event that a gymnast is late to class, the coach will not be required to make up the time with the gymnast and older gymnasts will be required to warm themselves up before joining the class.

GYM MATS SET UP AND SET DOWN

The set-up of gym mats at the opening session is a huge task and classes can commence on time only if the set-up is complete. Parents and older gymnasts are required to help with this process. The same is required for mats set down at the completion of the final session for the day.

DUTY OF CARE & CONDUCT

Gymnasts consent to partake in classes at Aelita approved venues at their own risk and participate within their own limitations and capabilities. Some physical contact by coaches may be necessary to maintain / correct gymnasts' techniques. Coaches aim to take reasonable care to ensure they do not cause reasonably foreseeable injury to gymnasts via safe warm-ups and cool downs, and transitions. Gymnasts and their parents / guardians acknowledge that gymnastics and performance related activities can involve risks and possible elements of danger. Whilst gymnasts' safety is paramount when on the premises, Aelita cannot accept responsibility for their safety outside the gym. Foul language, bullying and disrespect to peers, coaches and volunteers are not accepted in any circumstance.

DISPLAYS & COMMITMENTS

Gymnasts will perform their group items in the Mid-Year Demonstration and End-of-Year Displays. All displays have a strong focus on gymnast skill development and encourage team morale with a positive spirit. It is important that gymnasts are committed to attending all classes.

DAMAGES & RESPONSIBILITY

The signatory will be financially responsible for any damage sustained to Aelita properties and / or gym fittings by the gymnast or their guardian. The signatory will be charged for any repair, labour or replacement as is necessary to reinstate item to previous condition. Aelita does not accept responsibility for the damage or loss of goods left on the premises prior to, during or after gym classes and performances. The gymnasts and their guardian are solely responsible for their personal belongings and property whilst on the premises. The gymnasts and their guardian shall make no claim adversely impacting, causing hardship or undue stress on Aelita.
